The Memphis Ministries Team has 20 ministry partners across the city. Our aim is to two-fold: first, to help First Evan engage our neighbors next door and across the city; second, to create reciprocal relationships between First Evan and our ministry partners.

GOALS ACHIEVED JULY 2023-PRESENT

- Increased ministry engagement opportunities through Come and See tables and Sunday School championing
- Shared six God at Work stories
- Made volunteering more feasible through Sunday School championing
- Collaborated with Student Ministries to provide mini-Meet Memphis opportunities throughout the year
- Increased funding opportunities by redefining funding criteria
- Established 10 Sunday School champions
- Identified 85+ current FEC volunteers serving with our partner ministries

- \$1300 Young Lives day camp for teen moms and their children
- \$500 Multinational after-school club supplies
- \$20,000+ Various Ministries students in the city to attend summer Bible camps

PARTNER MINISTRY UPDATES JULY 2023-PRESENT

- Advance Memphis 32 of the 47 graduates went to work through Employment Development.
- ARISE2Read ministered in 43 schools to conduct one-to-one tutoring and increased the number of Bible clubs offered to a total of eight.
- CEF reached 8323 students in 2023 through 347 volunteers citywide in 77 clubs.
- Life Choices Over 750 babies were born through their ministry effort.
- World Relief Served 878 refugees and immigrants in 2023
- Youth Striving for Excellence 16 students accepted Christ and six of them were baptized.
- BCA eight middle school students committed their lives to Christ and this led to a new discipleship group at school.
- Young Lives expanded the ministry to serve teenage fathers.
- FCA had 18 students find salvation and 40 athletes in regular discipleship with our staff.
- **Red Zone** opened a new safe haven called Opportunity Zone in Orange Mound.
- Memphis Union Mission in progress of a building project with seating for 350+ guests and volunteers.
