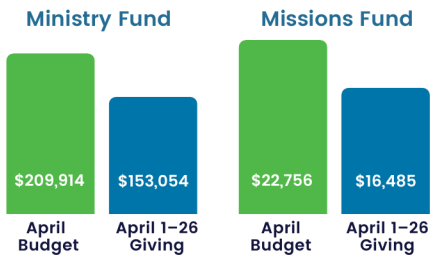
- For the 67 Good News Club held this school year with over 2,500 children enrolled. 54 children were saved and many grew in their faith!
