- That we are able to provide free produce once a month to families in Binghampton.

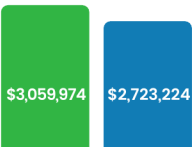

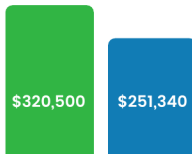
